Category	Subsidy Standards and Amounts
On-Campus Scholarships	There are a total of 25 on-campus scholarships, with amounts ranging from 2,000 to 20,000 NT dollars per recipient.
Financial Assistance for Underprivileged Students	Qualifying students from underprivileged backgrounds may receive financial assistance ranging from 15,000 to 20,000 NT dollars.
Encouragement for Overseas Exchange, Dual Degrees, Internships, or Volunteer Work	Each student is eligible for scholarships ranging from 20,000 NT dollars or more when participating in overseas exchange programs, pursuing dual degrees, engaging in internships, or volunteering.
Outstanding Athlete Scholarships	Scholarships are awarded to the university's outstanding athletes who achieve top-three rankings in events such as the Olympics, Asian Games, international championships, or university-wide competitions.
Work-Study Financial Aid	Financial aid for work-study positions is provided based on the university's work-study wage standards.
Living Allowance Scholarships	Students who meet the criteria for financial assistance can apply for monthly scholarships. Upon acceptance, they are required to engage in 30 hours of service learning each month and receive a monthly stipend of 6,000 NT dollars.
