Types of scholarship	Under-Graduate
Global Korea Scholarship for Graduate Degrees(GKS-G)	Available for all graduates or fresh graduates of our department to apply. Beisdes tuition fees and miscellaneous expenses waivers in Korea is offered, 900000 Won is provided too to those who pass the selection.
China-Korea Culture and Economy Association Scholarship	This scholarship provides 15000NTD per academic year, available only for Junior and Senior students to apply. (4 quotas in each grade, 8 quotas in total)
Scholarship for Korean Language Study in Korea	This scholarship is establised by the government of South Korea since 2012, which offer chances to sutdy Korean iat 10 Korean universities designated for one year. Only 1 quota available in each university. About 3 students from our department receive this scholarship every year.
Legacy Scholarship	Awarded to outstanding or disadvantaged students to provide them with the necessary assistance so they can complete their studies.
Hwa-Kang Scholarship.	Those who scored top three in their academic average score among their class will receive 8000 NTD, 5000 NTD, and 2000NTD respectively. Available to apply every semester.
Scholarship for Outstanding Foreign Language Proficiency	5000 NTD is awarded , will be evaluated by the Department of Korean Language and Literature according to examination result. Only 10 quotas available.
Scholarships for the top three winners of national foreign language competitions or performances	Awarded to those who on first-second-third place in national foreign language competition. The amount of this scholarship depends on the results or performance of the performers. First place will get 5000NTD, Second place will get 3000 NTD, and third place will get 2000 NTD. Scholarships for contestants will be doubled.

MINISTRY OF EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR SCHOLARSHIP STUDENTS TO GO ABROAD
